Montana Pass-Through Entity (PTE) Tax Return for Partnership and S-Corporations

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Introduction

The material in this publication will provide software developers the necessary information for capturing and formatting Montana tax data required to submit a complete Montana Pass-Thru Entity (PTE) tax return for Partnerships and S-Corporations. This publication does NOT replace the requirements, procedures, etc., issued by the IRS. All IRS requirements must be adhered to in the development of the Montana return.

What Has Changed for Tax Year 2023

A schema change log is posted as a separate document on the State Exchange System with all changes to the schema for the 2023 Tax Year as referenced below. The Requirements documentation listed below can be found on the State Exchange System located at https://taxadmin.kiteworks.com/

- The 2023 Schema package for Business Tax returns will be posted to the State Exchange System. The version is titled **MTBusiness2023V1.0.** The Pass-Thru Entity (PTE) schemas are in the **MTBusiness** folder titled **BusinessReturnPTE.xsd** and **ReturnDataPTE.xsd**
- A schema change log is posted as separate document on the State Exchange System with all changes to the PTE schema for the current tax year. The change log spreadsheet is named 2023PTEchangelogV1.0.xlsx
- The Pass-Thru Entity Tax Return Business Rules and Reject code excel document along with the Form Instructions are also posted on the SES website for your review.

What Forms Can Be Filed Electronically
