- This form must be filed if you are unable to file your Vermont Income Tax Return by the due date of April 15, 2024 and you are not filing a federal extension or if you are required to make an extension payment.
An extension only allows additional time to file the Vermont Income Tax Return and avoids a late filing penalty.
NOTE: This extension does not apply to Form HS-122, Vermont Homestead Declaration OR Property Tax Credit Claim.
