\$150,000 if married filing jointly or qualifying widow(er).
5. Divide line 3 by line 4. If one or more, enter 1.0000. 5 _____
6. Enter the 2019 standard deduction amount for your filing status or your total estimated 2019 Maine itemized deductions*, whichever applies 6 _____
7. Multiply line 6 by line 5..... 7 _____
8. **Estimated 2019 Maine itemized deductions or standard deduction.**
Subtract line 7 from line 6. Enter this amount on your 2019 Estimated Tax Worksheet, line 6a 8 _____
